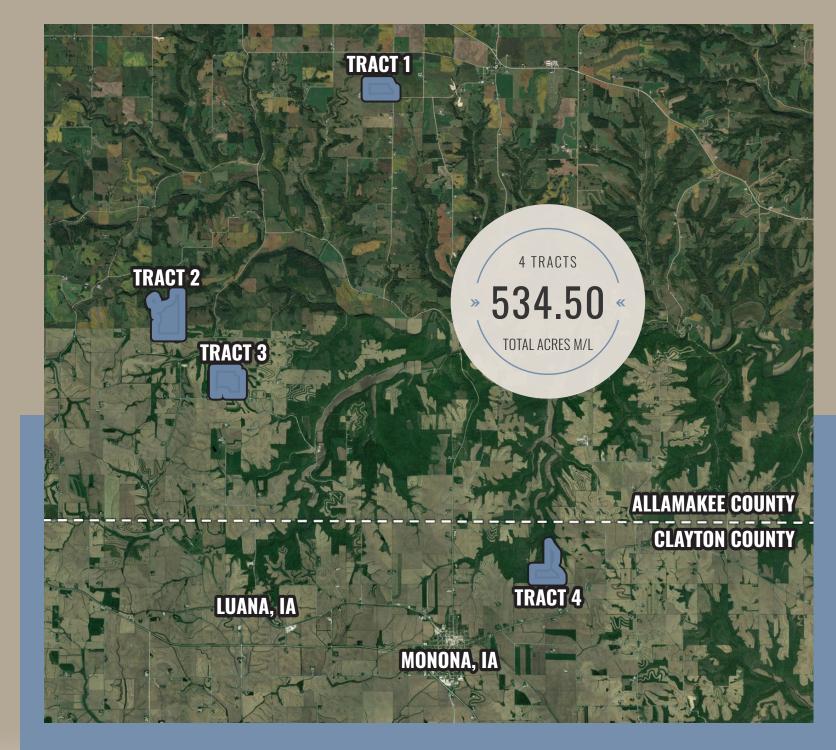

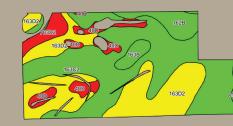

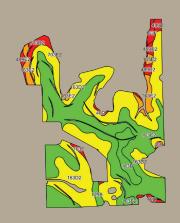

Tract two consists of 203.07 acres m/l with 152.52 FSA tillable acres carrying a CSR2 of 55.7. The primary soil type is the highly productive Fayette silt loam. There is an additional 9.56 acres m/l currently in pasture and over 33 acres of timber creating a great recreational value-add. Fall manure, nitrogen, and rye were applied on this tract along with some fall tillage work. This farm is located northeast of Postville, Iowa at the end of Daffodil Road in Post and Jefferson Townships of Allamakee County.



DIRECTIONS:

From Waukon: Travel South on Highway 9 for one mile to the T intersection. At the T, travel east/southeast on Highway 76 for 4.5 miles to Red School Road. Head south on Read School Road for 1.5 miles to the intersection of Red School Road and Peterson Hollow Drive. The farm is located on the northwest corner of the intersection.

DIRECTIONS:

From Postville: Travel northeast out of town on Cherry Valley Drive for 5 miles to Daffodil Road. Head north on Daffodil Road for 0.25 miles and the farm will be located on the east side of the road.

This tract is located east of Postville, Iowa at the corner of Jackson Hollow Drive and Shady Lane Road in Jefferson Township of Allamakee County.

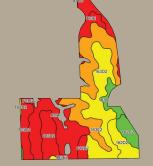

Turn east on Jackson Hollow Drive and the farm will be located on the north side of the road after 0.5 miles at the northwest corner of the Jackson Hollow Drive and Shady Lane Road intersection.

Tract four consists of 108.01 acres m/l with 101.92 FSA tillable acres carrying a CSR2 of 30.5. The primary soil types are Nordness and Fayette silt loams. These soils are known to produce an excellent crop for their prospective CSR2 values. With large blocks of timber found just north of this tract, there is an abundance of wildlife creating an opportunity to place deer blinds throughout the property and create a recreational hideaway with excellent income. Fall manure, nitrogen, and rye were applied on this farm and vertical tillage has been done. This tract is located northeast of Monona, Iowa along Golden Avenue in Giard Township of Clayton County.
